"Toward a Resilient Pinecrest", a first-of-its-kind climate change municipal workshop series, continues with a film and panel discussion at Pinecrest Gardens

Pinecrest, Fla. – "Toward a Resilient Pinecrest" workshop series continues with a film and panel discussion. On Wednesday, January 20th from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. "This Changes Everything", a film by Avi Lewis, will be shown in the Banyan Bowl at Pinecrest Gardens. The film will be followed by a panel discussion with panelists: Kamalah Fletcher of Catalyst Miami & Moms Clean Air Force, Caroline Lewis of The CLEO Institute, John Van Leer of Citizens Climate Lobby, and Mateo Van Thienen, Student & CLEO YTF Member. The panel will be moderated by Pinecrest Mayor Cindy Lerner.

Pinecrest spotlights climate change through this monthly workshop series that focuses on the most critical issues surrounding climate change that affect everyone. This is the fourth workshop offering since September to provide residents with critical information about the various aspects of how to prepare for changes as a result of climate change and sea level rise.

Filmed over 211 days in nine countries and five continents over four years, *This Changes Everything* is an epic attempt to re-imagine the vast challenge of climate change.
