Police arrest resident who reportedly burglarized at least three neighbor's homes

Pinecrest, Fla. – Pinecrest Police arrested Jessica Shere Coggins, 37 (DOB 9/8/78), Monday, August 29, 2016 at 10:26 a.m. and charged her with burglary to an unoccupied dwelling and grand theft in the third degree. Policed recovered jewelry and coins valued at \$20,000.

Coggins reportedly burglarized her neighbor's house in the 12500 block of SW 68th Court while they were on vacation between August 26th and August 28th. When detectives arrived at the scene of the burglary, they were suspicious of Coggins' interest in the burglary and her behavior. Coggins lives across the street from the victims.

Based on their suspicion of Coggins, police conducted a trash pull of Coggins' outside garbage canister. The garbage contained coins from various countries, and photographs of a second neighbor and his family who had reported a theft several months earlier.

When police arrested Coggins they found two jewelry boxes and a prescription bottle belonging to victim in her purse. They also found keys belonging to a third neighbor's house. The third neighbor/victim is the parent of the second neighbor/victim and lives nearby. Further investigation is needed to identify additional found items.
