- 1. Summary of the proposed ordinance (must include statement of the public purpose, such as serving the public health, safety, morals, and welfare):

The proposed ordinance provides for the creation of a two-tier Stormwater Utility Fee rate structure: a base fee to be levied against all parcels, whether or not developed, and a parcel fee to be levied against developed parcels (collectively, the "Stormwater Fees). The stormwater fees are imposed upon all residential developed property and all nonresidential developed property in the Village, sufficient to plan, construct, operate, and maintain the Stormwater Utility. Village Council finds the implementation of said fees to be in the best interest of the public, health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Pinecrest.

2. Estimate of direct economic impact of the proposed ordinance on private, for-profit businesses in the Village of Pinecrest:
The economic impact of the proposed fee on private, for-profit businesses is a cumulative savings of \$386,650.
3. Estimate of direct compliance costs that businesses may reasonably incur:
The fees levied rely on the total square footage of the structure, and therefore vary by business. Depending on its size, a business can expect to pay between \$99.51 to \$10,611.00.
4. Estimate of the Village of Pinecrest's regulatory costs, including estimated revenues from any new charges or fees to cover such costs:

Tier 1 Base Fee: \$99.51 plus Tier 2 Equivalent Base Unit of \$31.50 times the square footage of the structure rounded to nearest 100 square feet.
